Under Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) as per NEP, 2020 3-year UG Degree:

Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement.

4-year UG Degree (Honours):

A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme with 160 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements.

Undergraduate Degree Programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as:

- a UG Certificate after completing 1 year (2 Semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study, provided that a skill based vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 40 credits. These students are allowed to reenter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.
- a UG Diploma after 2 years (4 Semesters) of study, provided that a skill based vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 83 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.
- a Bachelor's Degree after a 3-year (6 Semesters) programme of study,
- a Bachelor's Degree (Honours) after a 4-year (8 Semesters) programme of study. If the students complete a rigorous research project/ dissertation in their major area(s) of study in the 4th year of a bachelor's degree then (Honours with Research).



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GENERAL GUIDELINES: ADMISSION IN 1ST SEMESTER

1. Admission in the 1st semester of 4 year/3-year undergraduate (UG) Hons./General Degree programes (under CCFUP as per NEP 2020) for the academic session 2023-24 will be online in standalone mode only and strictly on the basis of merit, that is, performance at 10+2/Equivalent level public examination(s) as determined by The University of Burdwan (Notification no. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/2 and HED Notification no. 354-Edn(CS)/10M95/14).

2. Before filling in the Application Form, applicants must go through all the information given in the college website to avoid unintended errors. Click on "Admission" Tab in the website (<u>https://www.collegetsm.in/admission/</u>) and to apply for admission go to Admission Portal: <u>https://www.collegetsm.in/apps/admission.php.</u> Online Registration Fee: Nil.

3. Candidates who have passed 10+2/Equivalent level examination from any recognized Council/Board/University (vide list of recognized Board/Council/University) in the year 2020/2021/2022/2023 can apply for admission in UG SEMESTER 1.

4. Reservation rules are as per G.O. and extant rules of Govt. of W.B.

5. Students admitted in any UG Semester I course in 2022-23, who after University Registration did not fill up form for Semester 1 Examination, can get admission afresh (new) in 2023-24 within available intake capacity, retaining their old registration. They only have to fill up enrolment form and upload Self declaration in Online Portal.

6. Merit lists will be published in the website as per the schedule.

7. Admission may be cancelled at any point of time, if any information provided by the applicant is found to be false.



Support Services

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The college has an internal Quality Assurance cell IQAC constituted as per the NAAC- guidelines. The cell regularly Monitors several academic, financial and infrastructural aspects of the college. The accuracy plays a pivotal role in designing quality plants and facilities, infra-structural development of the Institution and intellectual development of the staff members and the students.

Library

The college maintains a resourceful and well equipped library with computer and internet facilities. Students have access to the library on every working day from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Every student is entitled to borrow books from the library against their home-card and reading-card. The library also has a well-furnished and spacious reading room. Each student is supposed to strictly maintain rules and regulations of the library.

Women's Cell

The College also has a separate Women's cell for creating awareness among students and employees about issues and problems related to women.

SC/ST Cell & Minority Cell

The college has an SC /ST & Minority cell, which reviews existing and new facilities offered by the Government/ College for the SC/ ST & Minority students from time to time and creates awareness. The cell also supervises the seat reservation status at the time of admission. The college Administration effectively arranges timely disbursement of SC/ ST & Minority scholarship funds received from the government.

Grievance Redressal, Anti-Ragging & Anti-Sexual harassment Cell

The college has a grievance redressal and sexual harassment Cell where students and employees can record their grievances. The Cell promptly takes proper care of the Complaints, and based on the gravity of the situation, it refers the complaint to the higher authority i.e. the principle of the Governing Body. These cells also organize different seminars about Anti-ragging & Anti-sexual harassment for the awareness of students.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The college has an NSS wing. The student may also participate in the NSS program as a part of their cocurricular activity under the able guidance of program officers. Many online & offline activities are performed by the NSS Unit of our college.

Laboratory

Our college has a laboratory with modern materials required for studying Honours and Pass courses in Geography. Students must be able to use it with discipline.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES :

Attention is paid to the healthy co-curricular activities which are mainly carried on in cooperation with the Students' Union. These include Debates, Essay Competitions, Educational Tours, Social and various other Cultural functions and Sports and Games. Winners in the Annual Sports are awarded prizes and certificates.

ECO Club

The college has an Eco Club named 'BASUNDHARA'. It is formed to increase the students' awareness regarding contemporary environmental issues. The club undertakes various activities relating to Environment consciousness on the college campus. The eco club takes all possible initiatives to make the campus eco-friendly. The club planned to avoid or reduce the use of plastic on the campus to make the entire campus 'Plastic free'. The students and staff have planted various tree saplings during various

environment-related programs organized by the institution.

In order to achieve sustainable development, the college Eco Club aims to conserve, protect, and manage the environment. The Eco Club emphasizes the need to look closer at nature for a safer and greener tomorrow.

Electoral Literacy Club




